

PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT

Date: 03-02-2026

I, Det Brendan McGinnis, a Police Officer for the St. Joseph, Missouri Police Department, knowing that false statements on this form are punishable by law, state that the facts contained herein are true.

1. I have probable cause to believe that on 03-02-2026, at Victim's Address, Buchanan County, St. Joseph, Missouri, Harrison, Jaxx, committed one or more criminal offense(s): Assault-1st Degree, Armed Criminal Action, Unlawful Use of a Weapon

2. The facts supporting this belief are as follows:

I, Detective Brendan McGinnis, of the St. Joseph Police Department, have probable cause to believe, Jaxx Harrison, committed the crime of; Assault-1st degree and Armed Criminal Action, in St. Joseph, Buchanan County, Missouri.

The relevant facts supporting a probable cause determination are as follows: On 3-2-2026 at around 0233 hours, Mr. Harrison walked into the area of [redacted] Clay from the east, pulled a handgun, with laser, wearing black pants, distinct marking on leg, and black sweatshirt, firing multiple rounds into the structure of [redacted] Clay, damaging the residence and property inside the residence. Mr. Harrison then fled the scene to the east. Mr. Harrison's identity was not known at that time. The residence was occupied by 2 residents at the time of incident and the actions were caught on camera that was obtained from the residence. Officers were in the area and heard the gunshots and later approached Mr. Harrison, who was walking in the area. Mr. Harrison fled on foot and was later caught and arrested. The path Mr. Harrison fled, a handgun was located with a laser and Mr. Harrison was located wearing the same clothing seen on the video, with distinct marking. Mr. Harrison later gave a statement that he remembers doing some of this, but didn't intend to kill or hurt any person.

Based on the facts described and the inferences drawn from them, Mr. Harrison, committed Assault and Armed Criminal Action, Unlawful Use of a Weapon, when he used a handgun in the commission of a felony and Assault, by attempting to cause serious physical injury by shooting into an occupied structure, in St. Joseph, Buchanan County, MO.

(1) a danger to the crime victim because:

Mr. Harrison had made threats to a person in the residence, who he had a previous relationship with, that he was going to shoot up the residence. Mr. Harrison admitted that he was hurt, due to the relationship coming to an end and showed no regard for the safety of the victim.

(2) a danger to the community or other person because:

Mr. Harrison was intoxicated and fired several shots into a residence in a reckless and dangerous manner, with no due regard for the community or safety of the residents.
