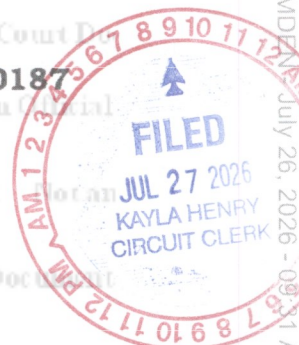

ORDER

ON THIS DATE OF July 27, 2026, comes Petitioner by attorney Bogdan Susan, and comes Respondent by Jim Spradlin, and Petitioner dismisses the Petition filed on July 9, 2025. The Court finds that:

1. Petitioner WAS lawfully arrested on said date.
